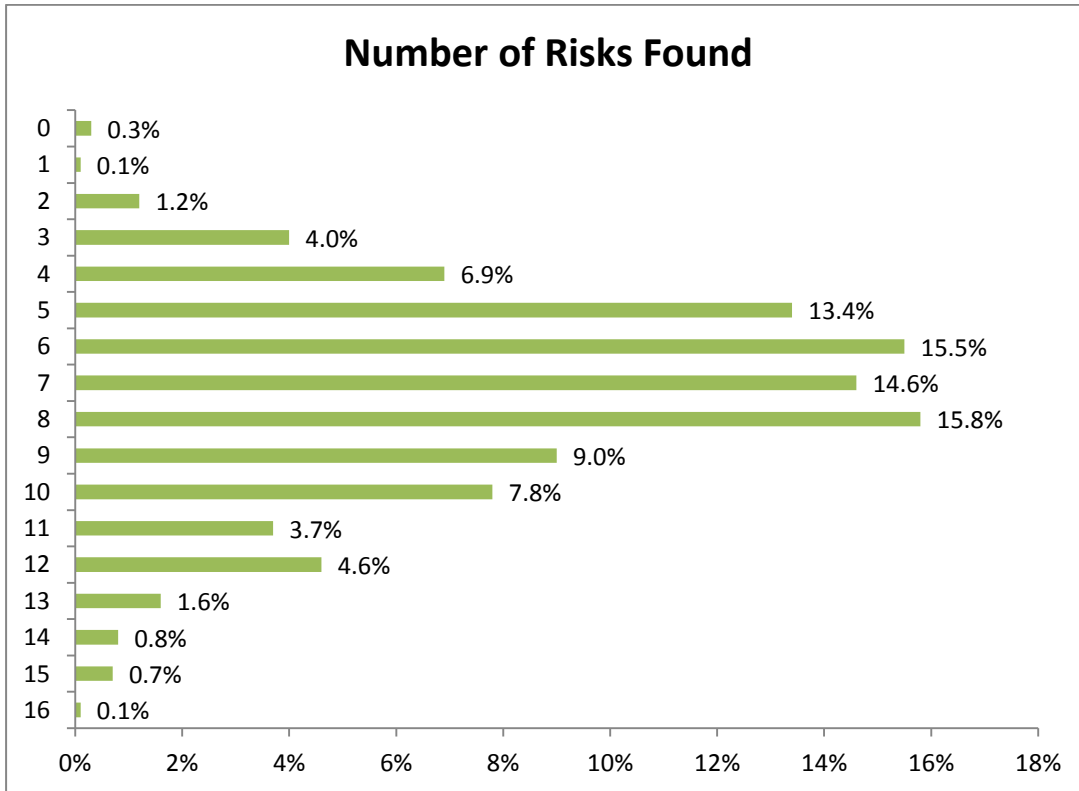

The Healthy Homes Screening Tool (HHST) is a screening tool intended for use within households by paraprofessionals and others to examine the health risks in surveyed homes by assessing the presence of a wide range of risk factors that may increase the potential for sickness, injuries, and death among a home’s inhabitants.

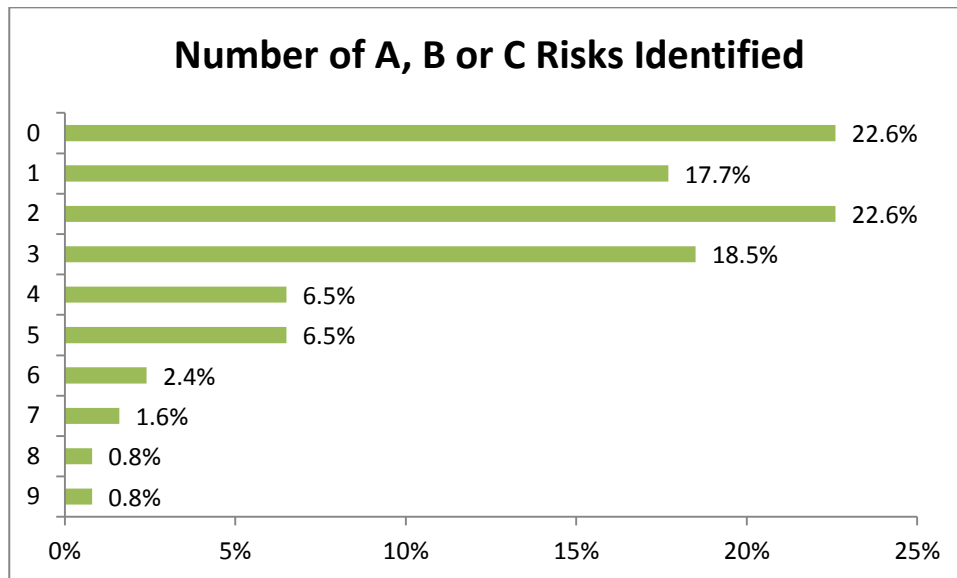
