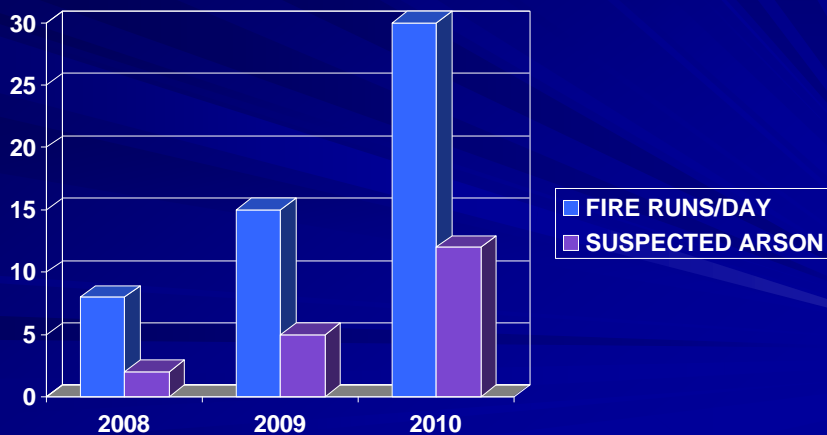

## CHM SMOKE ALARM PROGRAM

- Install one working smoke alarm on each level of the home to include the sleeping areas.
- Install one CO detector per home
- In home fire/burn safety education

## WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- Install smoke alarms/CO detectors
- Educate Families
