Homes Enrolled in Southwest GHHI



As of November 17:

- 164 assessments completed
- 111 homes referred to partner programs
- 269 total referrals made

Products To Date

- 846 total home safety products given including:
 - 333 smoke detectors provided by Kohl's Injury Prevention Program at Children's Hospital of Michigan
 - 134 carbon monoxide detectors provided by Kohl's Injury Prevention Program at Children's Hospital of Michigan
 - 110 deadbolts installed by AmeriCorps Urban Safety Program
 - 128 packs of light bulbs provided by AmeriCorps Urban Safety Program
 - 120 two pack window/door alarms provided by AmeriCorps Urban Safety Program
 - 14 door wedge alarms provided by AmeriCorps Urban Safety Program
- 11 radon test kits and educational materials provided by the State of Michigan

Referrals To Date

- 269 total referrals made including:
 - 78 City of Detroit 0% Interest Home Repair Loan Program (Bridging Communities)
 - 36 City of Detroit Lead Abatement Grant Program
 - 18 MDHHS Lead Safe Homes Program (CLEARCorps Detroit)
 - 43 DTE Refrigerator Replacement Program (CLEARCorps Detroit)
 - 27 WCHAP In-Home Asthma Education
 - 38 DTE Low-Income Self-Sufficiency Utility Assistance Program (United Way)
 - 24 Detroit Water Fund Water Assistance (United Way)
 - 4 DTE Furnace Test and Tune-Up Program (CLEARCorps Detroit)
- 33 home visits made by Jonatan

As of November 17, 2015

People Impacted To Date

- 619 people impacted
 - 244 children (under 18) impacted
 - 80 children (under 6) impacted
 - 61 households with older adults (over age 60) impacted
 - 5 households with a pregnant woman impacted
 - 59 households with individuals with a disability impacted
 - 12 households with veterans impacted
 - 122 homeowners impacted
 - 32 renters impacted
